

Prestigious City Development Gets Cellarcote Treatment

185 litres of Cellarcote were used to waterproof the basement of the former Natwest Headquarters in the City.

The waterproofing was carried out as part of the redevelopment of the Grade 2 listed building into Grade A City Specification office and retail space.

The nine storey, 160,415 sq foot property is owned by Grosvenor Estate Holdings and Royal Bank of Scotland and is set to become one of the most sought after office addresses in London.

Building work started on this major redevelopment in Autumn 2002 and is expected to be completed in the third quarter of 2004. The waterproofing work was carried out by Newport Building Services on behalf of main contractor Wates Building Group.

Cellarcote was chosen for the property's redevelopment thanks to its superior waterproofing performance and the speed with which it can be used.
