FUNGICIDAL WASH

DESCRIPTION

SEALOCRETE FUNGICIDAL WASH is a safe and effective water based treatment for killing mosses, lichens and all types of commonly occurring fungi and algae on walls, paths, driveways and roofs.

THIS PRODUCT SHOULD NOT BE USED AS A LAWN TREATMENT.

USES

SEALOCRETE FUNGICIDAL WASH can be used on concrete, brickwork, stone, roofing felt and most other building materials

Typical uses include:

- Removal of lichen from carvings and decorative stonework.
- To treat algae stains on masonry, brickwork, renderings and paintwork.
- To remove moss from roofs, guttering and downpipes.

METHOD OF USE

Thick surface growths are partly removed or torn with a wire brush and the wash is well brushed in.

Dilute the solution 1 Part FUNGICIDAL WASH to 1 Part water and work into the surface. The treatment takes a few days to become effective and in wet weather may be washed out before it has had time to act. It is

therefore preferable to carry out treatments during dry weather.

Where growth is severe, two applications may be necessary. Allow 24 hours between applications.

If the surface is to be painted or rendered, the dead matter must be removed by scraping, wire brushing or pressure wash, before application of subsequent material. Surfaces should then be washed with clean water.

Mould growth on internal surfaces is evidence of dampness. The source of dampness should be removed and surfaces allowed to dry before any further treatment.

COVERAGE

Coverage is typically 2 – 5m² per litre after diluting.

PACKAGING

FUNGICIDAL WASH is available in 500ml, 2.5 litre and 5 litre pack sizes.

CLEANING

Tools and equipment should be cleaned with water immediately after use.

STORAGE

FUNGICIDAL WASH should be stored in a cool, dry place away from frost. Shelf life is a

minimum of 12 months in unopened, sealed containers.

FUNGICIDAL WASH is approved by the Health and Safety Executive as a surface biocide (HSE 5373). For further information please refer to the Health & Safety Data Sheet and instructions on the container before using this product.
