POWDER GROUT

DESCRIPTION

POWDER GROUT is a compressible, cementitious grouting material, suitable for finishing joints of internal and external ceramic tile installations. When set, the tile grout is completely water resistant and will not wash out of joints. It is recommended for joints up to 3mm wide.

For applications where some slight movement of the substrate may be expected, FLEXIBLE POWDER GROUT should be considered.

Coverage	Approximately 4m ² /kg for joints 1.5 mm wide when using 152 mm x 152 mm x 5 mm or 108 mm x 108 mm x 4 mm tiles

PACKAGING

White: 0.5kg, 3kg, 5kg, 10kg, 20kg
Ivory: 3kg, 5kg, 10kg
Grey: 5kg, 10kg

METHOD OF USE

Preparation of Surface

Allow at least 24 hours from completion of tile fixing to application of the grout. When tiling over relatively impervious backgrounds, such as dense brick, concrete and existing tiled surfaces, allow the tile adhesive to set and dry before grouting.

Mixing

Mix POWDER GROUT to a creamy consistency with clean water. Allow the mix to stand for 15 minutes, then re-work thoroughly; do not add more water. The grout is now ready for up to 4 hours. Any mix remaining unused after 4 hours should be discarded. The addition of a Flexible Additive is strongly required for use in areas subject to slight movement and vibration.

Application

Using a rubber squeegee or plastic scraper, work the grout thoroughly into the dry tile joints and around all edges. Then with the aid of a pointed wooden tool the shape and size of a pencil, compact the grout firmly into the joints. Areas of about 1m² should be grouted and cleaned up before proceeding to the next area. Clean, dry cloths should be used to polish the tiles after completion of the grouting operation. Protect the finished work from frost until the grout has cured thoroughly, particularly in cold weather.

STORAGE

When stored in a dry place, shelf life is 6 months.

HANDLING

Avoid contact with hands. When skin contact occurs, wash off with clean water. Avoid splashing into eyes. If eye contact occurs, irrigate with water and seek medical advice. Please refer to the relevant product Health & Safety Data Sheet for further information,
